Day 1, Saturday: Zagreb

Upon arrival you will be transferred to your hotel. Free time before a welcome dinner at one of Zagreb's most loved restaurants. (D)

Day 2, Sunday: Zagreb - Ljubljana

Zagreb is home to a mix of 18th and 19th century buildings with many charming parks, squares and city markets. Discover the city's sights then continue to Ljubljana. The lively city features a gorgeous pedestrian only Baroque Old Town nestled at the foot of Castle Hill. Dinner at the hotel. (B, D)

Day 3, Monday: Ljubljana - Bled - Radovljica - Ljubljana

Lake Bled ranks among the most beautiful alpine resorts. Enjoy a Pletna boat ride to Bled Island. Continue to the medieval castle perched high on a cliff top for a memorable lunch. Stop in Radovljica for a stroll through this magical little town. Return to Ljubljana for an evening at leisure. (B, L)

Day 4, Tuesday: Ljubljana - Postojna Cave - Predjama Castle - Momjan - Poreč See the subterranean world of the Postojna Caves by train. Photo stop at Predjama Castle, followed by a wine tasting at one of Croatia's best wineries. Arrive to Poreč, home to the UNESCO World Heritage Site Euphrasius Basilica from the 6th century AD. Dinner at the hotel this evening. (B, T, D)



Day 5, Wednesday: Poreč - Motovun - Rovinj - Poreč

Visit the medieval hilltop town of Motovun followed by lunch where you will experience a tasting of local truffles. Proceed to the seaside town of Rovinj, one of the most romantic towns on the Mediterranean, with its cobbled streets, squares and picturesque buildings. Return to Poreč for an afternoon at leisure. (B, L/T)

Day 6, Thursday: Poreč - Pula - Vodnjan - Opatija - Rastoke - Plitvice Lakes Depart for Plitvice, enroute see Pula and its impressive Roman Amphitheatre followed by a visit to a renowned family producer of olive oil. Continue to Opatija, the old playground of the Austro-Hungarian nobility. Photo stop in Rastoke. Overnight in Plitvice Lakes and enjoy dinner at the hotel. (B, T, D)

Day 7, Friday: Plitvice Lakes - Zadar - Split

The beauty of the Plitvice Lakes lies in its 16 lakes inter-connected by a series of waterfalls. Discover the National Park and have picnic lunch before continuing to Zadar. Zadar dates back to Roman times, see its beautiful promenade Sea Organ & Greetings to the Sun. Overnight in Split this evening. Dinner is at the hotel. (B, L, D)

Day 8, Saturday: Split

After breakfast enjoy some free time before joining your cruise. See Split's historic centre including Diocletian's Palace and cellars, the UNESCO World Heritage Site. Return to your vessel for a welcome cocktail and dinner. (B, D)

Day 9, Sunday: Split - Trogir

Begin cruising the coast, with a swim stop enroute to Trogir, a UNESCO World Heritage protected historic stone town, it is often described as an open-air museum. We explore the charming town with its narrow alleyways. Enjoy your evening at leisure. (B, L)

Day 10, Monday: Trogir - Bol - Hvar

Cruise to Brač for a swim stop at famous Zlatni Rat beach near Bol. Arrive to Hvar Town for a walking tour and excursion to visit a famous local winery and the Spanish Fortress. This evening you are free to experience the local restaurants and nightlife. (B, L, T)

Day 11, Tuesday: Hvar - Biševo - Vis

Cruise to Biševo and the Blue Cave, a natural phenomenon of colour and light (visit is weather dependent). On arrival to Vis Town, your time is at leisure. Visit the remains of the Roman thermal place, town museum, or simply enjoy the surrounds. (B, L)

Day 12, Wednesday: Vis - Korčula

Early morning departure to Korčula Island with a stop for lunch in a secluded bay. Discover Korčula, an enchanting medieval town surrounded by stone walls. Later enjoy free time or take an optional excursion to a local village. (B, L)

Day 13, Thursday: Korčula - Mljet - Slano - Ston - Slano

See the saltwater lakes in Mljet National Park and enjoy a boat ride to St Mary Isle. Arrive to Slano, a small fishermen's village. Transfer to Ston, famous for its stone walls, salt pans, and oysters. Visit an oyster farm to learn about and taste this delicious treat. Return to the ship for Captain's farewell dinner with live entertainment. (B, L, T, D)

Day 14, Friday: Slano - Dubrovnik

Discover Dubrovnik and its breathtaking fortified city, it is often referred to as 'The Pearl of the Adriatic'. Enjoy a lunch cruise along the Dubrovnik City Walls before docking in Gruž Port. Transfer to the Old Town for a walking tour, followed by a cable car ride to Mount Srđ for scenic views of city and Elaphiti Islands. (B, L)

Day 15, Saturday: Dubrovnik

Say farewell to your crew and fellow travellers. Check out is by 0900HRS, you will be transferred to Dubrovnik Airport. Sretan Put. (B)
